Plagiarism Form

Plagiarism is a serious offense as it is essentially theft of another person's intellectual property. Plagiarism is the act of extracting and using content from a book, webpage, article or any other form of written media and presenting it as your own without referencing the source. This includes verbatim quotes and paraphrasing.

If one is using material from another person that material must be referenced properly. There are several referencing models available such as the Harvard system, The Oxford system and the American Psychological Association system. Illumin8 does not specify which system is to be used but we do require referencing to be completed properly.
